The Egg Shed from Dunkeld provides us with eggs used in our home baking and sandwich fillings. Our meats in our ciabattas, sandwiches and pizzas come from MacDonald Bros Butchers and Campbells Prime Meat and our salmon is from Dunkeld Smoked Salmon.

The delicious range of cakes we sell are made in our own kitchen using the finest ingredients and our Gluten Free range is supplied by Lazy Days Foods near Coatbridge. Jam for our scones are supplied by Sarah Gray's Preserves (Arbroath) and our chutneys by Galloway Lodge Preserves (Castle Douglas). These are also sold in our shop.
